

PLANTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR BONSAI SEEDS

1. Remove all components from the seed kit case.
2. Place a thin layer of pebbles in the bottom of your ceramic bonsai container to allow for good drainage.
3. Fill the container with the bonsai soil leaving about an 1/8 inch from the top.
4. Scatter the bonsai seeds on top of the soil and then sprinkle a small amount of soil to lightly cover them.
5. Water the entire container until the soil is wet and water drips from the hole in the bottom.
6. Carefully place the container into the bag and close the top to form a terrarium environment.
7. Place in a window or outside where it gets good light.
8. Keep the soil moist at all times by misting daily and keeping about 1/4 inch of water in the terrarium bag. Never allow the soil to dry out.
9. In just a few weeks, you should start to see growth from your seeds.
10. After about 8 weeks you should have several starter plants to choose from. Gently pull up the trees from the soil and replant into other containers to make bonsai.
