

# GUIDE TO LUCKY BAMBOO



## ABOUT LUCKY BAMBOO

Lucky Bamboo is botanically known as *Dracaena Sanderiana*. According to ancient Oriental folklore, Lucky Bamboo plants were given as gifts to friends and loved ones during times of celebration. A wedding, birth, birthday, housewarming, new business endeavor or just an expression of wishing someone Good Fortune are all perfect times to give gifts of Lucky Bamboo plants.

Lucky Bamboo has such popularity because they are so easy to care for and have such a powerful significance in the art of Feng Shui.

Lucky Bamboo is one of the plants recommended by Feng Shui masters to improve the flow of *CHI* or life's positive energy in a room, house or building.

## LUCKY BAMBOO CARE

- Keep water filled to the top of the container at all times as Lucky Bamboo requires fresh water to survive.
- Lucky Bamboo loves low to moderate light. Keep inside away from direct sunlight. This is one of the few indoor houseplants that will thrive in the low-light conditions of one's home or office.
- Some leaf yellowing is a natural occurrence. Should a leaf turn yellow, remove by pulling it off.
- Excessive heat or cold will cause your Lucky Bamboo plants to turn yellow and die. Keep away from temperatures below 45 and above 90 degrees F.
- Every two weeks, spray the plants with water to keep them free of dust and insects.
- Change the water once a month by pouring out the old and adding fresh water to the top of the container. We recommend using "Eve's Lucky Bamboo Fertilizer" once a month when changing the water to keep healthy and deep green.

## GROWING LUCKY BAMBOO

You can propagate new Lucky Bamboo by taking cuttings off your original stalks. Once the foliage is at least 8 inches long, cut off the shoot at a 30 degree angle leaving 1 to 5 inches at the main stalk. Place this cutting in fresh water and in about 30 days you will have a new, rooted Lucky Bamboo stalk.

To force a Lucky Bamboo stalk to produce another shoot, make a small slice on the stalk about 1/4 inch above a segment on the cane. In a few weeks, you will see a new bud.

## LUCKY BAMBOO DESIGNS

**STRAIGHT STALKS** represent a beginning, but never an end. They are regarded in Feng Shui as a work in progress depending on other elements for their meaning. It is almost as if they are neutral and by being placed in an arrangement they become part of something.

**SPIRAL STALKS** express concentrated power or growth of energies moving towards its center. Feng Shui teaches us that *spirals* have pulsating energy fields, drawing energy into its center.

## NUMBER OF STALKS

**ONE Stalk:** A single stalk is perfect for the North position of the house. One is the number of the North and a stalk here symbolizes various types of Good Fortune, including longevity, protection, staying power, and wealth.

**THREE Stalks:** In arrangements containing THREE stalks, the small stalk represents your PAST, the middle stalk represents your PRESENT and the taller stalk represents your FUTURE.

**FIVE Stalks:** In arrangements containing FIVE Stalks, the small stalk represents your PAST incarnations on earth, the second stalk is your PAST, the third stalk is your PRESENT, the fourth stalk is your FUTURE, the fifth stalk is your NEXT LIFE.

## COLORED RIBBONS

**RED:** *Enhances good fortune and prosperity.*

**GOLD:** *Represents wealth in terms of money and family.*

**BLUE:** *Represents royalty, knowledge and wealth.*
